ORDINANCE NO. 3314

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH BENJAMIN YOUNG TO SERVE AS CITY MANAGER AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CHARDON TO EXECUTE AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT WITH BENJAMIN YOUNG TO SERVE AS CITY MANAGER AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY was read for the first time by title only.
